Deemed **Forest City** because of our 200+ parks, preserved woodlands, meadows, ponds and miles of paved bike paths along the Thames, London was intended to be the capital of Canada.

London also recognizes the land on which we've built our city as the traditional territories of several First Nations communities, specifically the Anishinabewaki and Attiwoonderonk, among nine others.

REGISTRATION AND TRAVEL

HOW TO PAY: REGISTRATION

Chapter funded delegates: CISV London will invoice chapters

Self-funded delegates: Chapter will be invoiced; please arrange payment with your chapter

CISV Canada Funded delegates: Registration for delegates will be paid directly by CISV Canada. You must register by September 9, 2019 for the reduced early bird fee! If you register after the early bird deadline or request a single room you will be responsible for the additional costs.

HOW TO PAY: TRAVEL

Self-funded delegates/Chapter-funded delegates: Each participant is responsible for making their own travel arrangements to NBM/NJBM (in coordination with their local chapter.) If you are funded by your chapter please confirm the Chapter's travel policy with your Chapter Chair. If you are self-funded, you may make travel arrangements independently or through Alison Hastings.

CISV Canada Funded delegates: If you are funded by CISV Canada, you must book your travel through CISV Canada's Travel Agent, Alison Hastings (alison.hastings@tieronetravel.com).

IMPORTANT TO NOTE

*DEADLINE TO REGISTER OR CANCEL IS

OCTOBER 9, 2019.

*Individuals who register but do not attend will be charged the full registration fee. After October 9th you will be responsible for paying your fees whether or not you attend NBM.

*Registration fees are transferable (if you find you can't come, find someone to take your place - preferably of same gender) - however, changes to registration will not be accepted after October 25th

*Single room upgrade available to Adults (19+) only

*Day rate includes all sessions, lunch, dinner and social night

TRAVEL LOGISTICS

GROUND TRANSFERS

Ground transfer options are still being discussed, but stay tuned for more details in Info Pack #2!

(It is your choice whether you fly into Toronto or London, whether that be most cost effective, or for tourism purposes. However, if you choose to do so, you are responsible for arranging and covering the cost of your ground transfers.)

LONDON AIRPORT

You will be flying into the London Airport (YXU). WestJet, Air Canada, and Swoop all fly here. Some flights may require connections depending on where you are flying from, and which airline you are traveling with.

TORONTO AIRPORT

Air Canada, WestJet, and Porter fly into Toronto Pearson (YYZ). For some people this may be most cost effective.
